The WZB Berlin Social Science Center seeks to fill one position in its **Democracy and Democratization** research unit that is part of the Dynamics of Political Systems research department. It seeks

one student assistant

to support the 'MARPOR Manifesto Research on Political Representation' (project manager: Dr. Andrea Volkens) project from 01.12.2014 until 31.3.2016 (with the possibility of an extension) with a weekly workload of 15 hours. MARPOR is a long-term scientific endeavour financed by the German Research Foundation (Deutsche Forschungsgemeinschaft) that collects and content-analyses election manifestos for comparative studies across countries and over time. It seeks to provide the scientific community with these manifestos and with party positions (such as left-right positions) derived from a content analysis of these documents, which cover 75 countries and will span a period from 1990 to 2021. MARPOR continues the international co-operation initiated initially by Comparative Manifestos Project (CMP).

Tasks: Support in processing electoral programs, content-analytical data and secondary data on parties and elections. Tasks include data preparation, data management, analysis as well as literature research.

Requirements:

- Studies in political science, social sciences, psychology, economics, computer science or related fields
- Interest in the comparative study of parties and democracies and/or interest in quantitative content analysis
- · Good command of the English language
