The WZB Berlin Social Science Centre, Research Unit Migration, Integration, Transnationalization in the Research Area Migration and Diversity, is offering a position for a

student assistant

for the period from July 1, 2015 (possibly earlier) to December 31, 2016 (with the possibility of contract extension) and with 8 to 12 weekly working hours (to be individually fixed on starting date of the contract).

The position is in the third-party funded research project "Growth, Equal Opportunities, Migration and Markets", where we will conduct a field experiment (correspondence testing) to examine ethnic discrimination on the labor market.

Tasks: Support of project staff in their research: maintenance and programming work on an existing programme (PHP based), assistance in the implementation of the experiment (control and inputting of data into a database), research assistance.

Requirements: Applicants should be a student in computer science, social science or related disciplines; have good PHP and Drupal knowledge; have experience with SQL databases; show interest in (computer-based) experimental research; have good knowledge of German and English language; be able to work in a diligent and conscientious way; prove reliability and teamwork abilities.

Remuneration: in accordance with German civil service standards (TV Stud II Berlin, currently 11,24 Euros per hour)

Equally well-qualified disabled persons will be given preference. The WZB expressly invites women and people with an immigrant background to apply.
